COVID Policy

A face covering is required inside the clubhouse for:

- individuals 12 years of age and older who have not yet received one COVID booster shot.
- children ages 5 to 11 years of age who are not fully vaccinated. For this age group, fully vaccinated means they have received their primary series of two Pfizer vaccine shots.
- children two to four years old.
- Children under the age of five should be accompanied inside the clubhouse by an adult.
- Anyone who by our club policy is required to wear a face covering in the clubhouse may be inside the clubhouse for restroom use only.
- Children who are under two years old and too young to wear a face covering may be in the clubhouse for restroom use only.

Implications for Social Events, Activities and Clubhouse Usage

- To attend a Pamet Harbor Club social event at the club, participate in indoor member-led activities such as Darts, Mah Jongg, Needlework Mondays, and Book Club or participate in Yoga at the Pamet with Genevieve Morin of Truro Yoga, you must have received at least one COVID booster shot. Also, to use the clubhouse indoors "informally" (Ex: Bring your lunch and eat on the enclosed porch or watch TV in the main room) you must also meet the "one booster shot" requirement.
- Proof of booster shot through a vaccination card or similar must be given to me prior to the event, activity or informal clubhouse usage. Thank you for your cooperation with the implementation of this policy. You can send me a scan or photo of your vax card via email or text to 508-514-1879. Showing up at a social event, activity, or just for informal usage without having already submitted proof in advance is discouraged. This includes Happy Hours for which we do not currently require registration, but we do compile an attendance list of members and guests. We also compile attendance for Mah Jongg, Darts and Needlework and Yoga.
- Most of our club social events, like Happy Hour and Music Nights are for adults (18+). However, our Fourth of July Celebration scheduled for Saturday July 2 may be attended by those in the 5 to 17 year old age group if they are fully vaccinated (5 to 11 yo) or have at least one booster (12 to 17 yo) and so are NOT required to wear a face covering by our club policy.
- Children 4 years or younger are NOT eligible to attend the Fourth of July celebration under our current policy.

We are not requiring face coverings for outdoor activities such as boating, kayaking, tennis and pickleball. However, if our indoor policy would require a face covering for someone, we encourage that person to practice social distancing outdoors and consider the use of a face covering as well.
